<p>Meeting Venue (at the Campus of Universidad Autónoma de Madrid): Building No. 4 in the map</p> <p>You have different options to get to the Campus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Train station: Cantoblanco Building No. 27 in the map - Bus stop: Universidad Autónoma No. 28 in the map <p>Once you get to the Campus, you need to walk to Building No. 4 (Facultad de Ciencias Económicas), on the first floor to the left at the “Sala de Juntas de Decanato” (see second map).</p>	
From Sol	Take Metro line 1 from Sol to Chamartín (12 stops) and then take train line C4a or C4b to Cantoblanco (2 stops) – 41 minutes. (location in university’s map Building No. 27)
	Take Metro line 1 from Sol to Plaza de Castilla (11 stops) and then take bus 876, ALSA-716, ALSA-712 or ALSA-713 to Carretera M607-Universidad Autónoma (9 stops) – 46 minutes. (location in university’s map No. 28)
	Take train line C4 from Sol to Nuevos Ministerios (1 stop), then take train line C7 to Chamartín-Clara Campoamor (1 stop) and then take train line C4a to Cantoblanco (2 stops) – 42 minutes. (location in university’s map Building No. 27)
	A taxi will take around 30 minutes and it costs between 25-35 Euros.
From the Airport	If you arrive at Terminal T4 , take (direct to the university) bus 827 (Madrid/Canillejas – Tres Cantos, direction Tres Cantos) or bus 828 (Madrid/Canillejas – Universidad Autonoma, direction Universidad Autonoma) – about 35 minutes (location in university’s map No 28) (If you arrive at Terminal T1, T2 or T3 you have to take the Shuttle between terminals)
	If you arrive at Terminal T4 , take train line C10 to Chamartín-Clara Campoamor (3 stops) and then take train line C4a to Cantoblanco (2 stops) – 50 minutes. If you arrive at Terminal T1, T2 or T3 you have to take the Shuttle (free) or the Metro line (paid) to Aeropuerto T4 (2 stops) to take the train line C10, but it’s better to go with Metro till Chamartin (two next options) (location in university’s map Building No. 27)
	Take Metro line 8 from Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3 or T4 to Nuevos Ministerios (5 stops), then take Metro line 10 to Chamartín (4 stops) and then take train line C4a to Cantoblanco (2 stops) – 51 minutes. (location in university’s map Building No. 27)
	Take Metro line 8 from Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3 or T4 to Colombia (4 stops), then take Metro line 9 to Plaza de Castilla (3 stops) and then take bus 876, ALSA-716, ALSA-712 or ALSA-713 to Carretera M607-Universidad Autónoma (9 stops) – 54 minutes. (location in university’s map No. 28)
	A taxi will take around 15 minutes and it costs between 20-30 Euros.
