| Getting from the airport to the University:

The S-Bahn (suburban rail network) line S1 operates every 10 minutes between Hamburg Airport and Hamburg's central railway station, Hauptbahnhof, a journey of only 25 minutes. The "Hamburg Airport (Flughafen)" S-Bahn station is directly in front of the terminals and is easily reached by lift, escalator or stairs. Take the S1 and leave the train at Hamburg's central railway station (appr. 15-20 minutes). Please change here to S11, S21 or S31 (just cross the platform) and then go only one more station to "Dammtor". Head west to the University main building (3 minutes' walk).

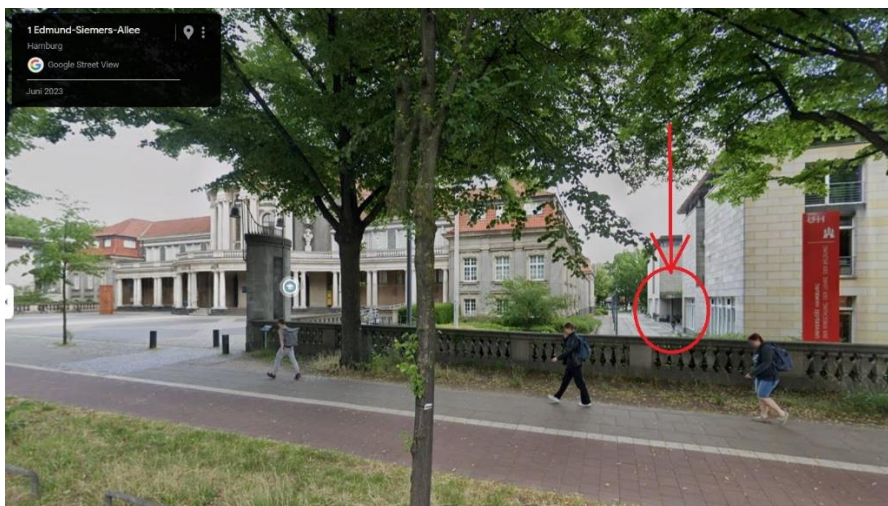
With the [HVV App](#) you can buy your tickets online.

If you need to use transport for more than 1 trip a day, 1-day tickets are the cheapest option. Tipp: Use the HVV ship line 62 with the day ticket (included in the price) to visit Hamburg by boat from the water (Starting at "Landungsbrücken").

Please note: It is not possible to pay with cash or card on buses.

| Getting to the University:

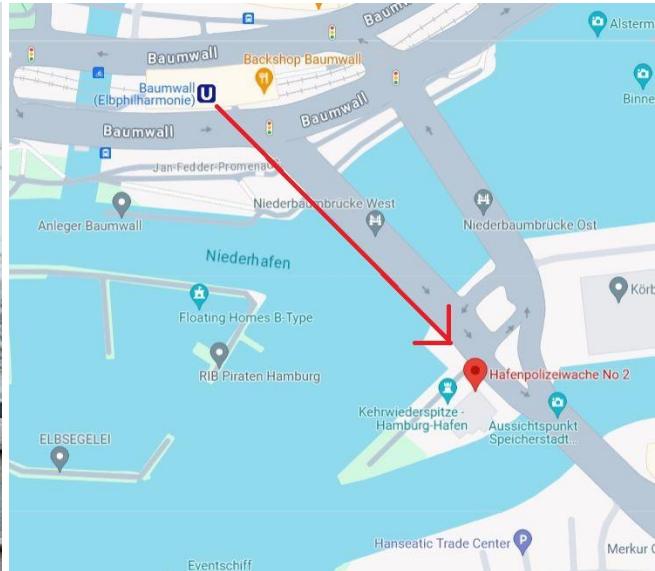
ESA Ost – Edmund Siemers Allee 1 - Entrance
